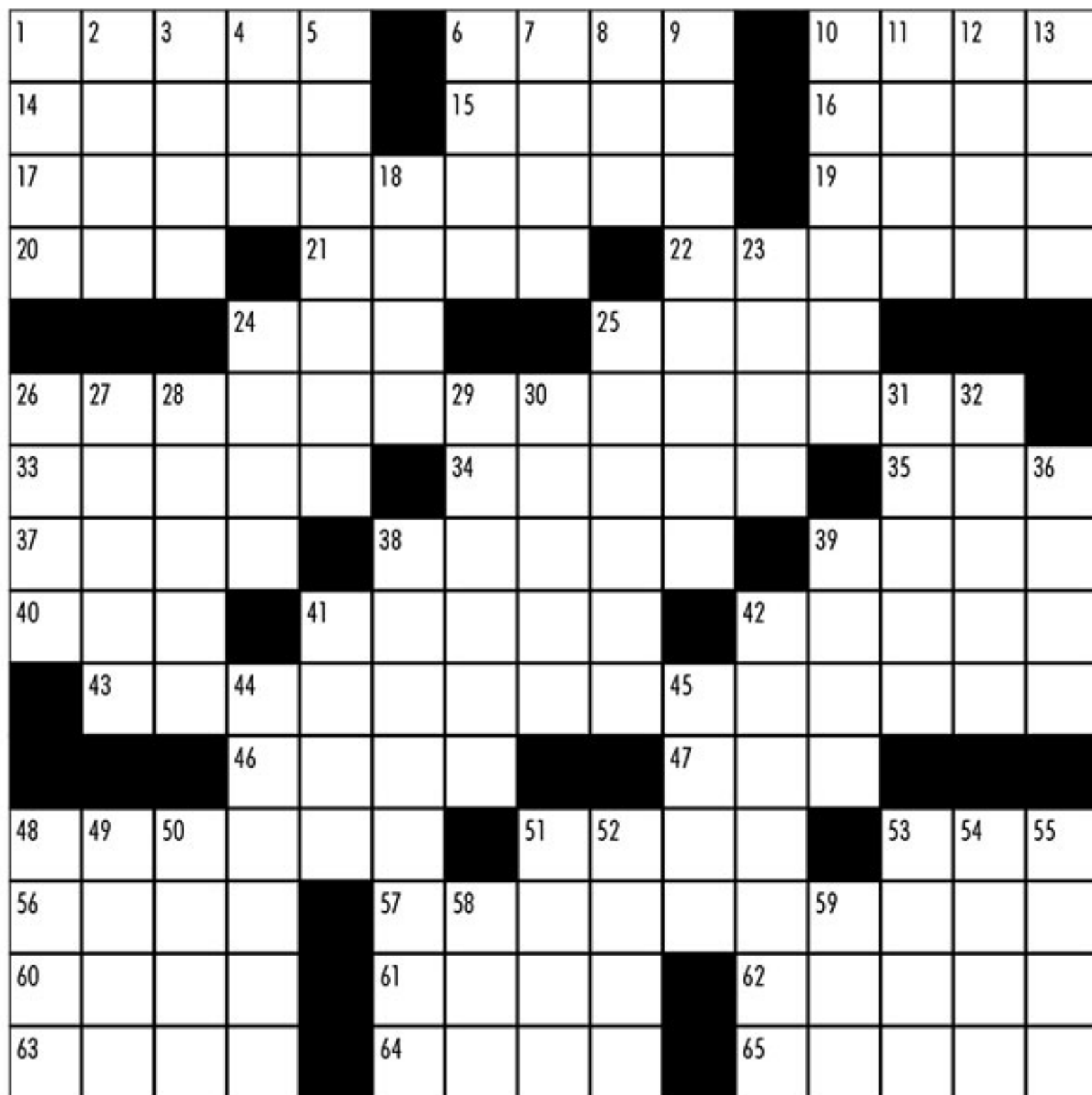


The Vulture Crossword Contest: That's a Laugh!
